We are working alongside the St Vincent DePaul society to collect food to be donated to a Catholic Food Pantry. We have selected the Pantry on the South Side, Fr. Vince has 3 Parishes, St Mary's, St Leo's and St Ladislas. I have communicated with Deacon Roger, from St Mary's and there is a great need for the surrounding community. We are looking to schedule the drive the weekend of March 20 & 21st. There will be more communication regarding their needs.

Additionally we are scheduling our Measure up collection May 1. We are in need of volunteers to help with the collection. Many hands make light work. If we could muster 20 or so Brothers we could have small shifts of an hour or so.

That hour goes by fast! Remember as a Knight you are



supporting Special Olympics, what could be a greater cause, then assisting those that need assistance the most!

We are discussing hosting another Degree this spring possibly in late April or May. The Exemplification only takes about 30-40 minutes. Finally, I would like to announce our Council has submitted a request to host the Silver Rose here June 29. This would follow the Tuesday Mass and include a prayer service.

St. Darerca of Ireland "Mother of Saints" Fifth Century March 22



Local traditions identify one of St. Patrick's holy sisters as "Darerca," who may have been among those kidnapped and taken into slavery earlier in the siblings' life. It is said that Darerca became the mother of many children (some traditions say 17 children total); most of them were boys. These boys eventually became influential in establishing the Church in Ireland as they became bishops throughout the country. Furthermore, many of these bishops are regarded as saints, such as Saint Mel of Ardagh, Saint Rioc of Inisboffin, Saint Muinis of Forgney, and Saint Maelchu. St. Darerca is patroness of Valentia Island, the westernmost point of County Kerry. Her feast day is celebrated on **March 22**.
