The Apostle of Andalusia (an autonomous region of Spain) and the spiritual advisor of St. Teresa, St. Francis Borgia, St. John of the Cross of the Cross, St. Peter of Alcantara, and others.

He was born on January 6, 1499, at Almodovar del Campo, Spain. After studying law at the University of Salamanca, he left the university to be a hermit.

He then went to Alcalá, where he was ordained. John drew great crowds with his fiery denunciations of evil and his many sermons.

A brief imprisonment by the Inquisition in Seville made him even more popular. His missionary efforts were centered on Andalusia, and his letters and other writings have become Spanish classics.

St. John was canonized on May 31, 1970 by Pope Paul VI and he was named a **Doctor of the Church** on October 7, 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI.

OLP May Crowning

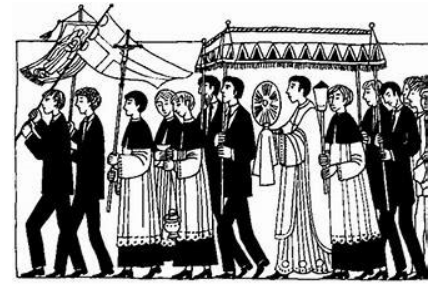
Honor Our Blessed Mother, patron of Our Lady of Peace Parish during her month of May.

Corpus Christi Procession



Very early in the fourteenth century the custom developed of carrying the **Blessed Sacrament** in a procession through the town after the Mass on Corpus Christi Day.

The Council of Trent (1545-1563) solemnly approved and recommended the procession on **Corpus Christi** as a public profession of the Catholic faith in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Sacrament.

Our Lady of Peace Parish is planning its own **Corpus Christi Procession** through the neighborhood streets of the parish. **It will be held on Sunday, June 6, 2021 after the Noon Mass.**

Fr Dooley is asking all of the OLP Knights to participate in this historic procession.

Silver Rose Service



Each year, from early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are stewarded by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada, the US and Mexico. Every stop the Silver Rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the

advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

In 2001 Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, labeled the program "Running of the Rose", and adding to it 'One Life, One Rose', symbolizing the commitment of the Knights of Columbus to Our Lady of Guadalupe, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and restoring respect for the sanctity of human life from conception until natural death.

There are currently eight Silver Roses traveling throughout North America, three of which will make their way every year to the Our Lady of Guadalupe Basilica in Monterey, Mexico.

OLP Parish History

On **June 12, 1946** Bishop Michael Ready purchased property located at the corner of



N. High Street and E. Dominion Blvd. The 3.5 acre site included a large lot, with 300 ft. facing High Street. The property was purchased from **Benjamin F. Patterson** (1867-1952) (pictured above). It included a 10 room house located at 22 East Dominion Blvd. The realtor was the C. R. O'Neil Company Realtors, who represented both parties in negotiations. John D. O'Connor of the Connor and Nestor law firm represented the Diocese.
