*Absent but remembered were 45 knights. They were killed in the terrorist attacks a year ago in New York City, at the Pentagon outside Washington and in Pennsylvania. "We pray for the thousands of good people who died, 45 of whom were our brother Knights of Columbus," said Bishop Thomas V. Daily of Brooklyn, N.Y., Supreme Chaplain of the fraternal organization, during the homily at the afternoon Mass.*

*Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, referring to Sept. 11, 2001, said that "90 percent of Americans prayed that day for our nation and victory over the terrorists. Surely that day we were one nation under God."*
