Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary Solemnity December 9



The Solemnity of the Immaculate

Conception celebrates the solemn celebration of belief in the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary. It is universally celebrated on December 8, nine months before the feast of the Nativity of Mary, which is celebrated on September 8. The Immaculate Conception is one of the most important Marian feasts in the liturgical calendar of the Church, and is celebrated worldwide. When December 8 falls on a Sunday, the feast is moved to December 9 (as in 2019).

According to the Papal Bull *Commissi Nobis Divinitus*, dated December 6, 1708, Pope Clement XI mandated the feast as a Holy Day of Obligation which is to be celebrated in future years by the faithful.

On May 17, 1846 the bishops of the United States meeting at the Sixth Provincial Council of Baltimore proclaimed Mary, under the title of her Immaculate Conception, the principal patroness of the United States.

Eight years following her being named Patroness of the United States, Pope Pius IX in 1854 defined the Immaculate Conception as a Roman Catholic dogma, most missals referred to it as the Feast of the Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The **Basilica** of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception is a minor basilica and our national shrine located in Washington, D.C. The shrine is the largest Catholic Church in the United States and in North America, and the tallest habitable building in Washington, D.C.
