

St. Telemachus Monk and Martyr ? – 404 AD January 1

"The successors to the empire inherited the piety of their father. Honorius, who had received the empire of Europe, abolished ancient exhibitions the gladiators in Rome on the following occasion: A certain man name Telemachus, who had embraced the monastical life, came from the East to Rome at a time when these spectacles were being exhibited. After gazing upon the combat from the amphitheatre, he descended into the arena, and tried to separate the gladiators. The sanguinary spectators, possessed by the demon that delights in the effusion of blood, were irritated at the interruption of their cruel sports, and stoned him who had occasioned the cessation.

On being apprised of their circumstance, the admirable emperor numbered him with the victorious martyrs, and abolished these iniquitous spectacles." (Ecclesiastical History of Blessed Theodoret of Cyrus, 5th century, Book VI, Ch. XXVI)
