I apologize

for this coming so late! Brother Knights I want to thank you for your support of the **Football Crazr** fundraiser. The Council sold **162** tickets, exceeding our goal of 10% over last year's sale of 142, at a minimum we will receive **\$9.50 per ticket, \$1,539**. If statewide sales exceed more than 25,000 sold, we receive an additional 50 cents per ticket. Very good news!

The Fall Festival was very successful, thanks again to everyone who participated and helped out. It's an amazing experience to see so many families together and enjoying themselves, hearing the kids playing and running about, just being kids.

The Clothing Drive also was a huge success! Again we took a truck load of clothes,(thanks to Dave King whose truck we used) to McArthur. I am again overwhelmed by the generosity of this Parish. This year the Knights of Columbus will display 23 Billboards around Central Ohio with the theme, Keep Christ in Christmas. This is an increase from last year. Brother Jim Davoli is currently working with the Students here at OLP in creating their Keep Christ in Christmas Card theme.



We are holding a degree Exemplification here November 16th, we will induct 1 new Knight, **Jordan Hunt**. I invite all Knights to attend and welcome him in. I have also sent an email to all First Degree Knights inviting them to complete their Second and Third Degrees.

Hopefully you had noticed the Save The Date notice in the bulletin. Jim Silcott has secured Mozart's for a Valentine Dinner and Dance. The cost per person is \$35. St. **Dionysius of** Alexandria Bishop ?-265 AD **November** 17



Saint Dionysius,

Bishop of Alexandria, was the son of wealthy pagan parents. He converted to Christianity at a mature age. Later, he was appointed as the head of Alexandria's Catechetical School. and then became Bishop of Alexandria in the year 247.

Saint Dionysius devoted much effort to defend the Church from heresy, and he encouraged during the persecutions under the emperors Decius (249-251) and Valerian (253-259).

The holy bishop endured much suffering in his lifetime. When the Decian persecution broke out. Saint Dionvsius was forced to flee Alexandria, but returned when the Emperor died. He was later exiled to Libya during the reign of Valerian.

When he resumed his duties in Alexandria in 261, Saint Dionysius had to contend with civil war, famine, plague, and other difficulties.

Saint Dionysius illumined his flock through his preaching, and with deeds of love and charity. An illness prevented him from attending the Council of Antioch (264-265), and he died while it was in session.

The influence of Saint Dionysius extended beyond the limits of his diocese. St. Basil called him "Dionysius the Great." His feast day is November 17.
